Brace yourself for an unprecedented fundraiser event on July 28, 2012, as we transform Highway 75 into a 'no speed limit' zone for the First Annual Sun Valley Road Rally brought to you by the Blaine County Community Drug Coalition and sponsored by The Sun Valley Auto Club and Blaine County Sheriff.

This event is a celebration not only of the progress made, but also of the programs we are developing and sustaining in a collaborative effort to improve the health and safety of Blaine County by decreasing alcohol and other drug use, especially among our youth. Over time and with your financial support, the Blaine County Community Drug Coalition hopes to build comprehensive programs, practices and policies across the entire community. Less alcohol and drug use by our youth and healthy, proactive messages and modeling from Valley adults is our goal.

SPECTATOR RULES & INFORMATION

All spectators are responsible for knowing this information

1. Registration for spectators who buy spectator tickets (unaffiliated with a driver) must register at the check-in point on Saturday morning at River Run or Baker Creek. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 28th. Spectators will park their cars either at the UPPER River Run Parking Lot or Baker Creek, pick-up tickets and complete registration which will include signing a waiver to gain admittance to and from the spectator zone (if not completed prior). Shuttles will transport all spectators to the designated spectator zone and back from both locations.
2. Registration for spectators who are signed up via a driver registration form must register and check-in at the Sun Valley Auto Club on Friday July 27th with the registered driver. Failure to do so will result in a mandatory RE-REGISTRATION at the rally course on-site registration desk. Spectators via driver registration form are required to wear a Sun Valley Road Rally lanyard.
3. Spectators who opt not to attend the River Run Concourse will be parking at the Baker Creek Parking Lot. Therefore, please keep the following in mind:
 - a. Drivers will begin the rally at 10:00 a.m. At this time, Highway 75 will be closed to through traffic and will be re-opened every 15 minutes. PLEASE arrive no later than 9:15 a.m. to ensure that you are able to complete the necessary waivers, obtain proper wristbands and load shuttle to be transported to designate spectator area in time to watch the first participants.
 - b. Spectators who arrive after 10:00 a.m. will have to wait at registration until the road re-opens for shuttle service to the spectator zone. This occurs every 15 minutes.
4. All pre-registered spectators are required to wear a Sun Valley Road Rally wristband.
5. Foot Traffic on the rally way is only permitted by driver participants, their approved crew/guests and the Sun Valley Road Rally staff only.
6. Spectators under the age of 18 must be with an adult at all times. Parent/guardians of all children under the age of 18 will need to sign a waiver for the child attendee.
7. ALL spectators must complete an on-site waiver at registration.
8. Participants and spectators are **not allowed** to bring pets.
9. No glass bottles are allowed
10. Please be respectful of your surroundings – the event is taking place in the Sawtooth National Recreational Area. Please pick-up after yourself. If you damage the grounds in any way, including the roadway, corridor, flora and/or fauna, you will be held liable for the damage.

11. No alcohol is permitted during the rally.
12. No barbeque pits, cigarettes or flames during the event.
13. Blaine County Sheriff's Department and Officers will be serving as Sun Valley Road Rally security during the event.
14. During the Event, no one is allowed past the boundary cones that line the span of the rally track unless they are TOW/PUSH CREW for a participant. Spectators must remain in the roped Spectator Area and are unauthorized to leave unless accompanied by Sun Valley Road Rally event staff.
15. In case of an incident/accident on course, the family, friends, and crew of the participant should meet at the finish line to receive updates. Family, friends, and crew are not allowed to get on the course or pass through the cones.

**STAFF, VOLUNTEER, AND SPECTATOR AGREEMENT AND RELEASE
LIABILITY WAIVER & PERSONAL INJURY DISCLAIMER**

General Stipulations: I am attending the Sun Valley Road Rally as a driver participant, spectator, volunteer or worker for fun and recreation. I agree to follow the directions of the Sun Valley Road Rally officials. I understand that I may be excused from participation and asked to leave the grounds if the Sun Valley Road Rally officials deem my behavior or that of anyone with me is disruptive to the event. I agree that I willingly accept the risk of driving, walking, monitoring, volunteering, staffing or standing near the stretch of road that makes up the rally site, knowing that it may be dangerous. I understand that I am responsible and accept the liability for the safety of any passengers that I take out on the closed road in my car during the event. I understand that there is a possibility that I and/or my guest(s) could be injured or killed at the event. I hereby release the Sun Valley Road Rally, the State of Idaho, the Idaho Transportation Department, Blaine County Community Drug Coalition, Sun Valley Events, their officials, officers, members, workers, sponsors, spokespersons and other participants ("Sun Valley Road Rally Crew") against all suits, claims or losses including costs, expenses and attorney fees incurred as a result of any act or omission, neglect or misconduct of The Sun Valley Road Rally or the participants during the event. Likewise, I release the "Sun Valley Road Rally Crew" from any liability or damage to my car or equipment, theft of the same, injury or death of myself and anyone accompanying me at the event, which may result from my participation in this event. I will not damage the pavement or leave fluids such as oil, fuel or coolant on the pavement. I understand that if I damage the grounds in any way, including an on-track incident damaging the roadway, corridor, flora and /or fauna, that I will be held liable to pay for that damage. I understand that the use of alcohol or illegal drugs by either me or my guest(s)/crew will subject us to immediate dismissal from the event facility.

I understand that I am the only person responsible for the safety of myself and/or my vehicle. I understand and agree that I will ensure that all required safety components are properly installed or fit properly in my car and on me. I recognize and assume all risk of damage, injury and death that may be caused by a failure of any component of a participating vehicle. I understand that all forms of motor sports are dangerous and can kill me. I am an adult and accept all of these risks and agree not to join the litigious ranks of persons who believe all injury must be the result of fault by person with money.

I am not suffering from any diseases or disorders or under any drugs, legal or illegal, that would affect my performance during the event. This is to certify that these statements are true and accurate. I give permission to any hospital, institution or physician the right to treat me for medical conditions that might occur while attending the Sun Valley Road Rally.

I have read, understand and agree to all the stipulations outlined in this Agreement and Release.
